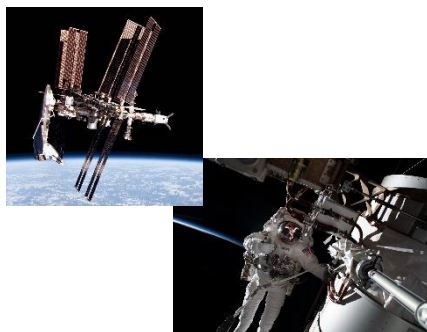


How did people learn how to fly?

Computing: Data handing – International Space Station
