At Madresfield CE Primary School, we aim for our music curriculum to inspire every child to achieve and to see themselves as a musician. The music experience children at our school enjoy, ignites and illuminates a love of and a life-long appreciation of music. The curriculum is creative, challenging and engaging for all children with enriching experiences whether that be working with music specialists from Seven Arts Music or listening to music being performed live by different groups of musicians of varying traditions and styles both within and beyond school. It equips them with and broadens their knowledge and skills so they can experiment and compose their own music using a wide-range of tuned and un-tuned instruments, alongside learning how to use musical notation. Children will develop appropriate language and vocabulary which will enable them to compose and critique pieces of music.

At Madresfield CE Primary School, our curriculum is designed so that pupils are curious about and are inspired by a wide range of difference musical genres. They will learn to distinguish different instruments from one another and articulate their responses and reactions to a wide-range of music through questioning and thinking e.g. how a piece makes them feel, why a composer chose to use a certain instrument or compositional device.
