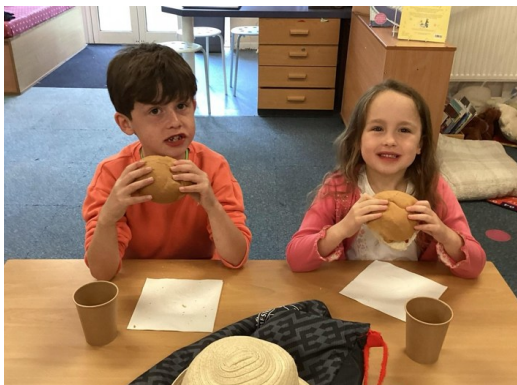
### New Football Kit

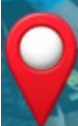
